- 4. Pray for the builders working on the new technical school. May they continue to work conscientiously and may God keep them safe from accidents.
- 5. Pray for the project of building the new multi purpose day centre. Pray that God will touch the hearts of donors so that money will come in for building.
- 6. Pray for Rosi, a fourteen year old girl living in the Girls' transit home. Her older sister wants her to go and live with her. This sister was living on the streets herself but now has a home of her own. Clement is praying for the sister and has invited her to come to church. The big prayer is that she will change and live at peace with her sister.
- 7. Pray for our country. Life is complicated. The exchange rate for dollars has dropped seriously but the price of food and other essentials does not go down. In Kinshasa they are trying to bring prices down but here in Lubumbashi it's very hard. People are really troubled and can't see a way out. The situation needs all our prayers.
